Cancer Walk Raises Record Total

More than 125 walkers and runners from throughout north central Connecticut joined together to raise a record \$15,000 during Johnson Health Network's Sixth Annual *A Reason for HOPE Walk/Run* for Cancer, held in September at Phoenix Community Cancer Center (PCCC) in Enfield. American Medical Response, Rockville Bank and The Phoenix Companies, Inc., served as major sponsors. All proceeds will directly benefit PCCC, which has been providing high-quality radiation

therapy and medical oncology services since 1998.

The event kicked off at 7:30 a.m., with a walk lead by the Connecticut Department of Corrections Honor Guard Bagpipe and Drum Band, Enfield Mayor Mary Lou Strom and cancer survivors. While many walkers raised generous contributions for their participation, **Vincent Grady** of Enfield won the prize for the most donations. He raised a total of \$1,400, for which he was awarded a pair of round-trip airline

tickets courtesy of **Continental Airlines**.

The walk portion of the event was followed by a timed 5K run at 9:30 a.m. **Bill Brosmith** of West Hartford was the first place male runner, while **Donna Kay-Ness** of Enfield was the first place female runner. They were also each awarded a pair of airline tickets from Continental Airlines.

Another Walk/Run is planned for next fall. Organizers look forward to the event growing bigger and better with each passing year.
